



Sachiko Hojo is an emeritus professor of Shokei Gakuin University, and a graduate researcher of Tohoku University School of Dentistry. She received both medical and dental PhDs from Tohoku University. Her specialties are environmental medicine and epidemiology. Over the past 30 years she has conducted multifaceted epidemiological investigations, including the preparation of a Japanese translation of the international common questionnaires to evaluate environmental hypersensitivity, confirmation of its reliability and validity and the setting of screening thresholds unique to Japan. She was a member of the research teams on sick house syndrome funded by the Ministry of Health, Labour and Welfare (MHLW), and now a member of the MHLW study group on central sensitization syndrome. She is the representative of Special Interest Groups on Environmental Sensitivity of the Japanese Society of Clinical Ecology and Society of Indoor Environment, Japan. She has also been collaborating on research with Dr. Lin-lin Haung in Taiwan since 2008.
